HIS HOLINESS THE DALAI LAMA

His Holiness the 14th Dalai Lama, Tenzin Gyatso, was born in 1935 and is the spiritual leader and Head of State of the Tibetan people. Since the Chinese invasion of Tibet, he has lived in exile in Northern India.

Today, he is known around the world as a great spiritual teacher and a tireless worker for peace. In his travels across the globe he crosses boundaries of religion and culture, bringing a message that offers comfort and inspiration; a message of love, compassion and forgiveness.

In 1989, in recognition of his work, His Holiness was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize.

PUBLIC TALK Inner Peace, Outer Harmony

With an emphasis on the practice and use of meditation in daily life, His Holiness the Dalai Lama will share his wisdom with all. His talk will be the climax of a Festival involving the whole City of Glasgow.

TEACHINGS AND INITIATION

Over the course of three days, the Dalai Lama will base his discourse on two classic Buddhist texts, Middle Stages of Meditation by the 8th century Indian master Kamalashila, and Thirty Seven Bodhisattva Practices, by the 14th-century Tibetan lama Togme Sangpo.

Acharya Kamalashila's text is a comprehensive practice manual on how to cultivate compassion and wisdom and establish conducive conditions for meditative practice.

The text by Togme Sangpo is a beautiful devotional poem in praise of the activities of bodhisattvas, those beings whose loving compassion inspires them to dedicate their lives to the service of others.

Mitrukpa Initiation

His Holiness the Dalai Lama will give an initiation into the practice of the Buddha Akshobhya, called Mitrukpa in Tibetan. The name Mitrukpa means one who is imperturbable, immovable and the practice of the sadhana of Mitrukpa is often recommended specifically for purification and for enhancing emotional stability.
